

A Conversation with Salima Alikhan, illustrator of Pieces of Another World!

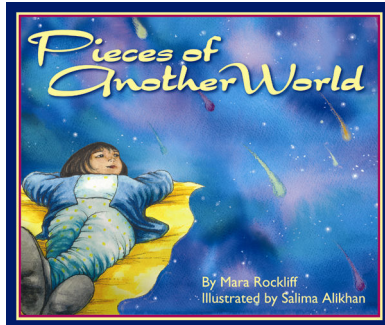


When did you decide you wanted to be an illustrator?
