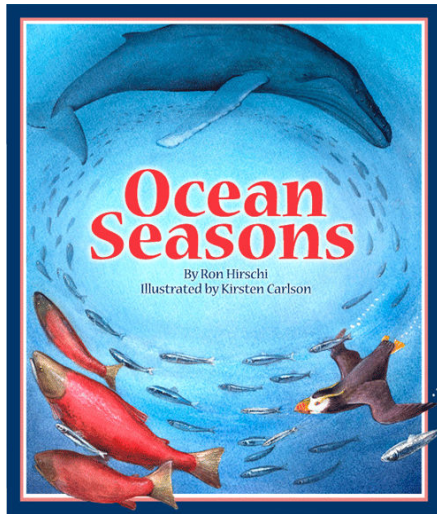

- Humpback whale migration information

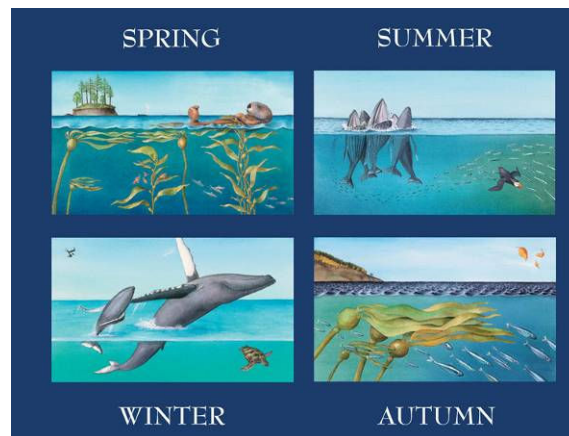
