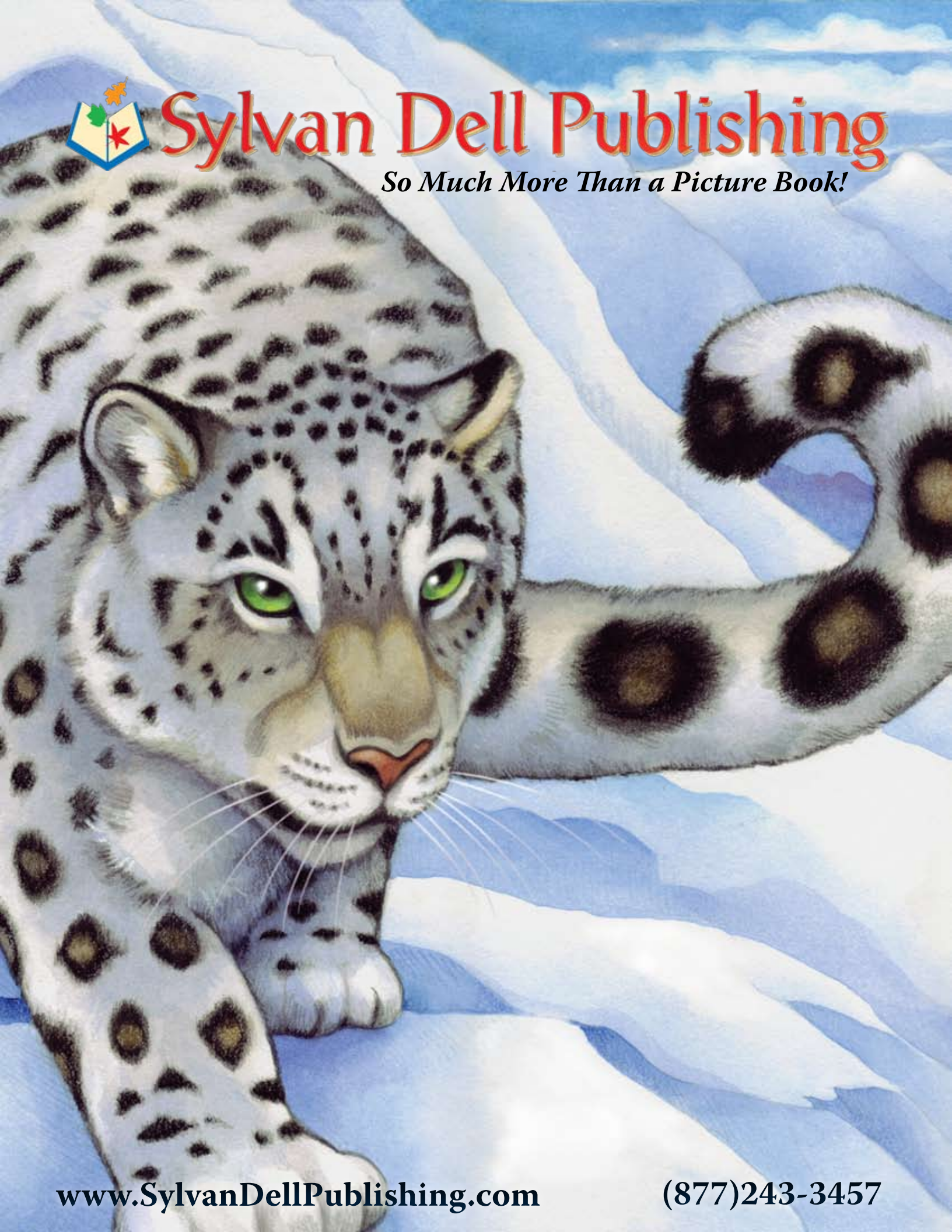

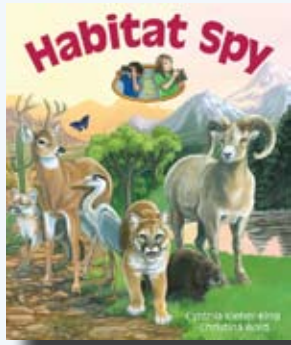

By Cynthia Kieber-King, Illustrated by Christina Wald

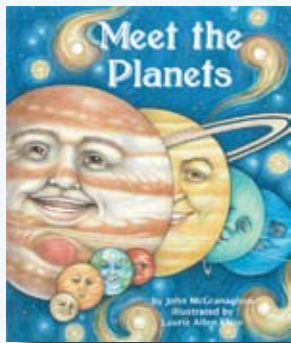

By John McGranaghan, Illustrated by Laurie Allen Klein

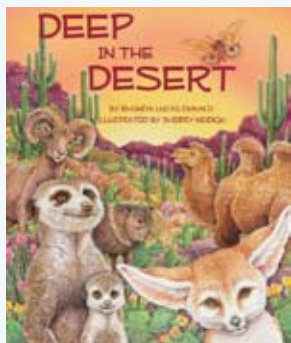

By Rhonda Lucas Donald, Illustrated by Sherry Neidigh

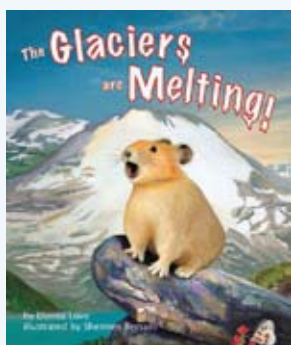

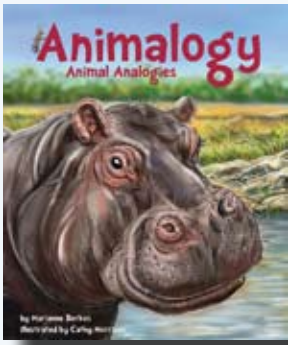

Animalogy

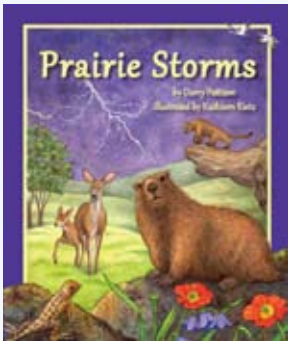

Prairie Storms

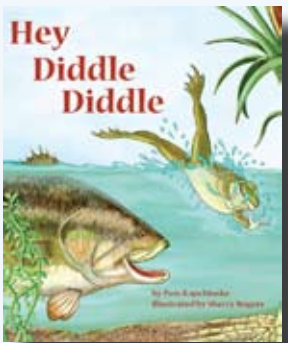

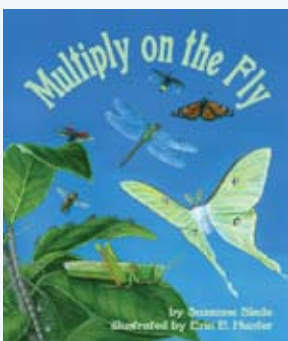
