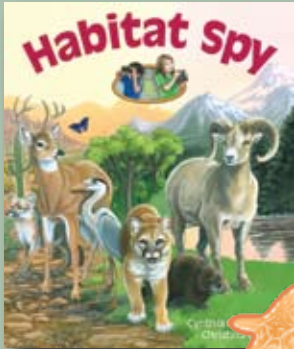


Habitat Spy
