### **What if You were a Parrot?**

**Mt. Pleasant, S.C.** (August 10, 2006) – Illustrator Sherry L. Rogers helps us imagine what the life of a parrot might be like in her new children’s picture book, “If You Were a Parrot.”

This whimsical story, written by Katherine Rawson and published by Sylvan Dell Publishing, will have children and adults imagine climbing around the house with four-toed parrot feet, chewing wooden spoons and popsicle sticks with hooked beaks and even eating vegetables like corn on the cob and broccoli.

“I have always wanted to illustrate children’s books,” Rogers explains. “Now that I have been given the opportunity, I want to reach as many children and adults as possible. That’s why I chose to use four children from different nationalities and gave them parrots from different parts of the world.”

“Parrot” is illustrator Rogers’ second children’s book. Her first picture book, “Counting Little Geckos,” was published in the summer of 2005. Additionally, Rogers is illustrating another Sylvan Dell title, “Burro’s Tortillas,” a humorous southwestern retelling of “The Little Red Hen.” The book will be available in 2007.

“I also snuck a little fun thing in the book,” Rodgers adds. “On one of the pages the parrot and child are chewing a telephone book—and the book is from my hometown, Rocklin, California!”

Educators at SeaWorld and the National Aviary vetted “Parrot” for scientific accuracy and Renaissance Learning recently selected the picture book for its Accelerated Reader Program.

Sylvan Dell Publishing is on a mission to create picture books that excite children’s imagination, are artistically spectacular and have educational value.
