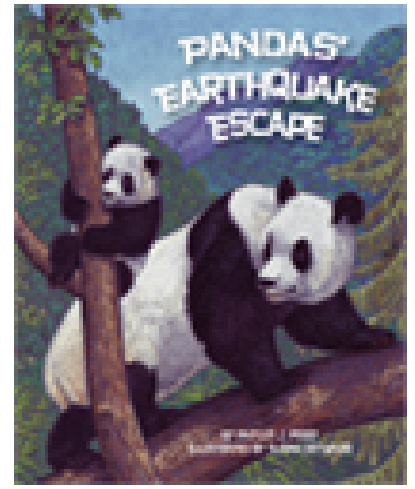


Schedule a School Visit with Colorado Children's Author **Phyllis Perry!**
