A School Visit With Carrie Get students excited about books, reading, and writing... invite an author to do a school visit!

As a former early childhood teacher, Carrie's intention is for every visit to be fun, memorable, and aligned with age-specific curriculum and classroom goals. She offers large group assemblies, small group writing workshops, teacher professional development, and PTO presentations.

Each presentation is engineered for specific age groupings and numbers of participants. Some topics include:

- The Story Behind the Story (a behind-the-scenes look at how a book is born): idea generation, writing stages, what happens at a publishing house and how author, illustrator, and editor work together.
- *Oh, Baby. It's Cold Outside: Animal Adaptations to Winter:* instinct vs. learned behavior, three main strategies animals use to adapt and survive, human vs. animal adaptations.
- *Making the Magic:* idea generation tips and tricks, turning an idea into a story, plot vs theme, dialogue, elements of memorable writing (five senses, universal themes, rich language)
- Let's Be Funny: adding humor to writing, what makes a story funny or not, authors and illustrators who make us laugh and how they do it
- *Taking It To The Next Level*: self-editing, partner critiquing, mentoring, what to let go, what to keep, and how to know.

Each presentation can include: Q&A, story reading (if appropriate), performing A Warm Winter Tail as a play, and book signing. Carrie can also divide her day between schools in close proximity.

Equipment: Appropriately-sized venue for group including microphone if needed, PowerPoint-enabled projector and computer in good working order, possible handouts

What's Next?

- 1. Coordinate with other classes (or schools or libraries), and decide what day works best.
- 2. Contact author directly to schedule date, time and details.
