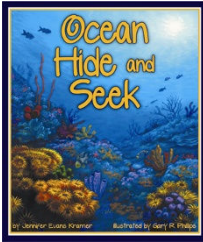

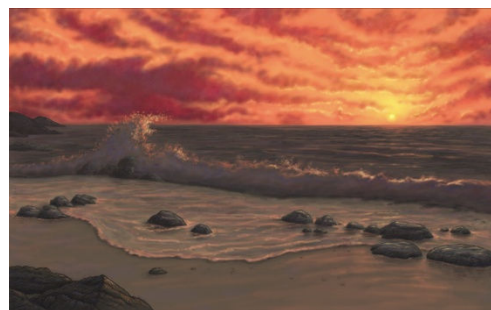
A School Visit with Jennifer...

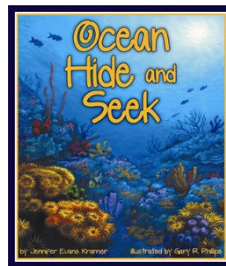
