Local children's book author Rhonda Lucas Donald introduces *Deep in the Desert*

**Mount Pleasant, S.C. (April. 14, 2011)** –Rhonda Lucas Donald introduces a new sing-along animal adventure in the picture book *Deep in the Desert* (Sylvan Dell Publishing). She specializes in writing about science, and especially likes to write about animals and space.

“I love writing about different habitats and the plants and animals living in them. Living nowhere near the desert, I find these arid ecosystems exotic and fascinating,” she said.

*Deep in the Desert* features catchy desert twists on traditional children's songs and poems that will have children chiming in about cactuses, camels, and more as they learn about the desert habitat and its flora and fauna. South Carolina artist Sherry Neidigh beautifully illustrated *Deep in the Desert*, and created to a vibrant, colorful world of desert denizens such as camels, fennec foxes, and ostriches.

Lucas Donald, originally from Staunton, Va., has recently moved back to Virginia after living for several years in Washington, N.C., where she wrote the book. She has written more than a dozen books for children and teachers, including her most recent titles: *Animal Rights: How You Can Make a Difference* and *Life on Other Planets*. In addition, she has won awards for articles and stories appearing in *Ranger Rick* and *Your Big Backyard* magazines. Weaving science into verses and songs is her way of making it fun. Lucas Donald shares her home in Petersburg with her husband, dogs, and two very dignified cats.

Lucas Donald has a number of events scheduled for the coming months in celebration of her new release, including a launch event at 3 p.m. on April 19 at Demolition Coffee, 215 E. Bank St, Petersburg.
